

**Beaver Dam Unified School District
Board of Education Minutes**

Special Meeting

October 4, 2010

A special meeting of the Beaver Dam Unified School District Board of Education was held on the above date at the Educational Service Center. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by President, Bev Beal-Loeck. Board members present were Bev Beal-Loeck, Kim Darst (arrived at 6:15 p.m.), Dan Feuling (arrived at 6:14 p.m.), Marge Jorgensen, Lisa Panzer, Chad Prieve, Gary Spielman, and Joanne Tyjeski. Board members absent were Jean Hill.

Mr. Steve Vessey, Superintendent, presented the district's data dashboard which consists of 14 points of data used to measure the district's progress with academic achievement and how the information will be reported to the board and community.

There was discussion regarding communication of the dashboard, common assessments, timelines, building goals, and interventions.

The board participated in a workshop to discuss the board's communication goal, which is "Work to increase two-way communication with all stakeholders in our learning community. We will document our communication efforts in the following areas: Parents, Community Members, Students, Staff, Board inter-communication, Communication between Board and Administration, and Communication between all grade levels 4K-12." They discussed ideas and activities to improve communication with the community.
